Our Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

At Clearview Intelligence, we are fully committed to achieving Net Zero carbon emissions by 2050. This commitment underpins our business strategy and is embedded in how we operate, innovate, and deliver value to our customers and stakeholders.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions represent the greenhouse gases produced prior to the implementation of any carbon reduction strategies. These emissions serve as the reference point against which all future reductions are measured.

Additional Context:

We report zero Scope 2 emissions as our office locations are leased from building management companies and we do not procure electricity directly. Our baseline emissions are distributed across the following office sites:

 - Ayrshire Office: 3.811 tCO₂e

We are currently in the process of finalising our emissions data for this reporting period. The carbon footprint figures for Scope 1, Scope 2, and Scope 3 emissions are being calculated and are expected to be **available and published by September 2025**. These will be shared transparently both on our website and with relevant stakeholders once validated.

Carbon Reduction Targets

To ensure we remain on track to achieve Net Zero by 2050, Clearview Intelligence has set the following targets:

- 50% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2030
 - 30% reduction in Scope 3 emissions by 2029
 - An additional 20% reduction in Scope 3 emissions by 2040
 - Achieve Net Zero across all operations by 2050
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Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Initiatives Since Baseline Year (2022–2023):

- Established our carbon footprint baseline (April 2022 – March 2023)
 - Maintained ISO 14001:2015 certification under our SHQE integrated management system
 - Achieved “On The Road To Net Zero” certification
 - Implemented a Safer & Greener Travel Policy
 - Converted four fleet vehicles to hybrid models
 - Initiated Net Zero dialogue with our manufacturing supply chain
 - Achieved Gold Status at the Supply Chain Sustainability School
 - Introduced a new expense system for improved carbon tracking
 - Removed polystyrene from M680 product packaging and eliminated individual plastic bags
 - Replaced PVC tape with recyclable Kraft paper tape in all product shipments
 - Switched MK4E and SolarLite Click products to an ABS Glass-Fill material, shortening the supply chain from the Far East to Europe
 - Launched waste segregation schemes across all office locations to align with ‘Simpler Recycling’ guidance
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Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives

By 2030:

- Transition all petrol and diesel fleet vehicles to hybrid or electric alternatives
- Prioritise public transport for business travel
- Install smart meters for electricity/gas usage at headquarters
- Opt for sustainable hotel options for business stays
- Maintain Gold Status with the Supply Chain Sustainability School
- Promote employee uptake of electric vehicles via salary sacrifice schemes
- Launch food waste composting initiative at HQ
- Implement PPE recycling programme
- Continue development of the Solarlite-P series, focusing on:
 - Zero hazardous materials

- Wildlife and dark skies friendliness
- Energy-free street lighting alternatives
- Easy, safe installation using non-hazardous materials

By 2040:

- Ensure all service offices operate on 100% renewable energy tariffs
- Install motion sensor lighting to reduce electricity usage
- Encourage hybrid workers to switch to renewable energy suppliers at home
- Transition to a fully electric vehicle fleet
- Recommend motion sensor taps to reduce water consumption at leased properties

By 2050:

- Reach Net Zero across all Clearview Intelligence operations
- Use 100% renewable materials in the manufacture of all Clearview products
